Training Course 1- Surveying from First Principles

Presenter: Rachael Musgrave-Evans LS

The training courses being offered by our office are primarily designed to provide surveying graduates with some training and support towards becoming registered as a Licensed Surveyor (graduates do not need to be in a formal Professional Training Agreement to be eligible to apply). These sessions will also suit people with a TAFE qualification (surveying) or those who have some level of work experience as a cadastral surveyor. These courses can also provide additional guidance to recently Licensed Surveyors.

Course Details:

This course has been designed to teach and familiarize participants with the following from first principles:

- Traversing principles
- Preparation of field cards
- Potential sources of error and how to mitigate those errors
- The ability to interrogate data collected in the field
- Preparation of worksheets
- Re-establishment computation exercises
- The capacity to question re-establishment results
- Quality Assurance processes for the checking of computations and final documentation.

Pre-requisites:

- Participants need to hold a surveying degree/diploma or have had some experience working as a cadastral surveyor. Recently Licensed Surveyors are also welcome to apply
- Must be able to bring along an HP calculator with closure programs

Cost:

- \$450 plus GST (capped at 20 places)
- Morning and afternoon tea provided; lunch is not included (many options for lunch available around venue)
