Training Course 3 – Rural Cadastral Surveying

5 Cadastral SRBV CPD Points

The training courses being offered by our office are primarily designed to provide surveying graduates with some training and support towards becoming registered as a Licensed Surveyor (graduates do not need to be in a formal Professional Training Agreement to be eligible to apply). These courses can also assist Supervising Surveyors with the training of candidates and also provide additional guidance to recently Licensed Surveyors (**5 Cadastral SRBV CPD points for Licensed Surveyors who register and attend**).

Course Details:

This one-day course will cover the principles of cadastral law as well as the re-establishment processes behind:

- Property Law Act 1958
- Government Road alignments
- Crown boundaries
- Ambulatory boundaries
- Reading and interpreting old survey information

Examples from our office will be used as case studies to consolidate the concepts being taught in the session.

Pre-requisites:

- Participants need to hold a surveying degree/diploma or have had some experience working as a cadastral surveyor. Licensed Surveyors are also welcome to register.
